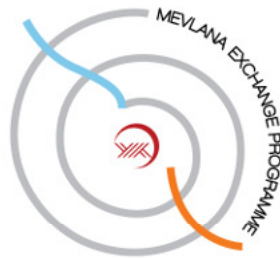

Mevlana Exchange Program is an international program between Turkey and higher education institutions from countries which are not a member or candidate of European Union and is conducted by the Council of Higher Education (YÖK). ESOGU has bilateral agreements with 26 universities from various geographies around world such as, Azerbaijan, Albania, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Iraq, Georgia, Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan, Mexico, Pakistan, Russia, Tanzania, Taiwan and Yemen.

Farabi Exchange Program is a national exchange program conducted by the Council of Higher Education (YÖK) which provides student exchange among Turkish universities within Turkey.

Every semester we organize a welcome dinner for the incoming students. This dinner was a chance to introduce incoming Erasmus students to our university students who are volunteer to help them.

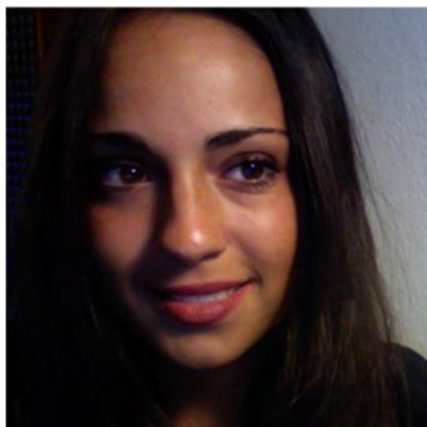
ANADOLU ERASMUS+ TRAINEESHIP CONSORTIUM

On October 20, 2015 we had our first consortium meeting at Anadolu University. Erasmus+ Consortium means a group of higher education institutions with Erasmus Charter for Higher Education (ECHE) and other organizations (companies, associations, chambers of commerce, municipalities, foundations, etc) coming together to offer more and better Erasmus traineeship opportunities to the students of higher education.

"Anadolu Erasmus+ Traineeship Consortium", which will last for 3 years, is an Erasmus project coordinated by Anadolu University with the partnership of Eskişehir Osmangazi University, Afyon Kocatepe University, Dumlupınar University and Eskişehir Chamber of Industry. The main aim of the foundation of the consortium is to create appropriate internship opportunities in EU countries for the students studying at the universities of the consortium.

Representatives of all five partner organizations gathered to discuss future plans. Anadolu Consortium plans out to send/receive Erasmus traineeship students this year. Soon the consortium will introduce new website with all detailed information.
